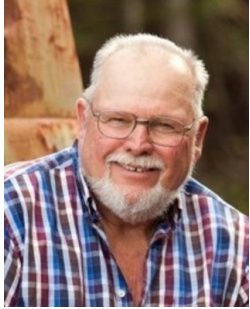

Douglas Edward Fludd(1951 - 2014)
