and assigns, part Lot of Land Number Two hundred and five on the west side
of Dry Creek in the the Twenty seventh District (27 district) Deatur County
in said State. Containing fifty acres more or less, together with all privileges and
appurtenances thereto in any wise belonging in fee simple. Which I warrant and
defend against the claim of any person or persons whatever. In testimony whereof,
